By Age Groups

- **Infants and Toddlers**

The Infant and Toddler Curriculums feature activities and equipment designed for development of gross and fine motor coordination. Care is individualized with attention to build strong foundations of love and security.

In the infant room, each child has his or her own crib and place for personal belongings.

The Toddler Curriculum offers hands-on learning experiences and development of motor skills. Toddlers have a spacious room to interact with their friends as well as tactile and sensory toys and soft climbing equipment.

- **Two-Year-Olds**

Two-year-old care centers on master new skills, develop independence, and learn social manners. Two-year-old children especially like to express themselves in dramatic play and construction.

Two-year-olds are introduced to the young preschool readiness A Beka program which emphasizes language development, listening skills, identification and classification of objects, numbers, and number concepts, art, manners, values, and self-help skills. Curiosity and discovery tendencies of two-year-olds are supported by the A Beka program.

- **Pre-School Aged**

Pre-school students are immersed in A Beka preschool curriculum that includes language arts and comprehension, phonics and listening skills, computers, vocabulary, literature, math readiness, art, manners and values and morals. The A Beka is designed to allow students to succeed and build positive self-esteem.

The pre-school care prepares children for kindergarten.

- **Kindergarten**

The A Beka Kindergarten Curriculum teaches in a fun and exciting way skills which a child needs to be prepared a school experiences. It enhances phonics and reading, writing

skills, science exploration, and math. Children explore addition and subtraction, classic literature, social studies, poetry, theater, music and art.

Important character values such as respect, integrity, cooperation, and teamwork are nurtured and developed at the kindergarten level. Children's Lighthouse also offers Spanish and computer literacy classes to kindergarteners.

Students complete kindergarten with a formal graduation ceremony.

- **School-Aged Students**

The school-aged student program supports the school program in which children are enrolled. A youth space is designed especially for 6- to 12-year-old students. Open both before and after school, school-aged children have a fun, challenging, supervised environment. It features a homework area, Lego toys, a big screen TV, arcade games, board games, computers and creative art.

Summer Camp and Holiday Camp experiences are part of the curriculum when the students are on school holidays.
