We have been part of the Children's Lighthouse family since our oldest daughter was 9 months old. I first visited CLLC while living in Carrollton and was impressed with the structured curriculum, the warm tasty meals and snacks, the friendly staff and teachers; the cleanliness of the rooms... the list goes on and on. We registered our daughter and immediately felt like we were part of an extended family. The teachers took care of her as if she was their own. We always felt welcome and appreciated and we never had to worry about our child after dropping her off.

Our daughter has learned so much while at Children's Lighthouse! The majority of her potty training was done at school and she was broken from the bottle with the assistance of the teachers in her class. She learned about Jesus, her colors, numbers, seasons, days of the week, animals, how to spell her name, etc.! I have met wonderful parents through my daughter's class and have made great friends with most of them! We always have classmates' parties to attend and school sponsored functions to enjoy.
